



In the pictures you can see the take down target frame in the frame holder and out of the holder. In this case the target frame was made out of 1x2's. I see no reason 2x2's would not also work very well. Remember the legs have to fit inside 2 inch PVC. In this design the card board is being held to the target frame by a wooden strip placed over the card board and held in place by (4) ½ inch bolts with wing nuts. By removing the wing nuts the target frame can be broken down to fit behind the seat of a car. If you use 2x2's I would recommend you remove the edges of the legs to give more clearance to fit inside the PVC. Targets are attached to the target frame with staples. The size of this design must be: 48 inches tall, 24 inches wide with a cardboard insert 24 inches square. Target frames that are taller than 48 inches are not allowed as the height of the target is what insures the impact of bullets are into the back stop at a safe place. Please help us continue to make our club a safe place to enjoy shooting. In the winter months we plan to put hole locators in the target frame holes on the range to allow you to find the holes once we get snow. Please do not shoot them and please replace them when you are done shooting.
