



In the above pictures you can see the target frame sitting in the frame holder and also a back view. These target frames are easy to build. All you need is (2) 2x2's, some scrap lumber and a hand full of dry wall screws. The sides to the target frames are 48 inches long. The cardboard is 24 x 24 inches and held on with some thin strips of wood made by running a 2x4 through a table saw. This makes it easy to change cardboard by removing the dry wall screws that hold the wood strips. You must remove the sharp edge of the 2x2 legs in order for them to fit in the holders. This can be done with a knife, hand plane & etc. The target frame holders will be installed (May 12th 2012) to hold only a target frame of this size, so please follow the directions. Targets are attached to the frame holder by use of staples. We plan to have a crew working on building these frames on our club work day (May 12th 2012) and some will be offered for sale at that time.
